Missy Miles will pursue the Mulch sale and see if we can participate this year.

Mr. Ziomek spoke to Deb Amman and Mr. Vivenzio regarding updating the library system and checking out books (as they are currently doing this at Pleasant Avenue). We might be able to fundraise through popcorn sales or profits from the book fairs to maintain upkeep of system. Would like to start installing it as soon as possible.
